


AVERAGE NUMBER OF PERSONS RECEIVING SALARY

- In September 2024, the number of persons receiving a monthly salary increased. The number of persons receiving a monthly salary increased by 2.6% compared to the corresponding period of 2023 and by 6.7% compared to the corresponding period of 2022.
- In September 2024, the share of persons receiving a monthly salary up to 600 GEL amounted to 15.5%, which was 3.1 percentage points less than the corresponding period of 2023, and 7.4 percentage points lower than the corresponding period of 2022.
- In September 2024, the share of persons receiving a monthly salary of 2,400 GEL and more amounted to 28.0%, which was 5.4 percentage points more compared to the corresponding period of 2023, and 9.7 percentage points higher than the corresponding period of 2022.
- In September 2024, the share of persons receiving a monthly salary of 9,600 GEL and more amounted to 2.3%, which was 0.4 percentage points more compared to the corresponding period of 2023, and 0.7 percentage points higher than the corresponding period of 2022.



TOTAL VACANCIES PUBLISHED ON Jobs.ge

- R In September 2024, the total number of vacancies published on jobs.ge amounted to 8,347, which was 12.1% higher compared to August 2024.
- From April 2024 to September 2024, the total number of vacancies published on jobs.ge amounted to 47,739, which was 6.5% higher compared to the same period of 2023.
- From April 2024 to September 2024, the average YoY growth of vacancies published on jobs.ge increased. From April 2024 to September 2024, the average YoY growth rate of vacancies published on jobs.ge was 7.1%, which was 1.4 percentage points higher compared to the corresponding period of 2023.

Graph 3: Number of Vacancies Published on jobs.ge






VACANCIES PUBLISHED ON Jobs.ge BY CATEGORIES

- Representation of the 2024, a total of 8,059 vacancies were published in logistics, transport and distribution, which was 19.2% higher compared to the corresponding period of 2023.
- Representation of the september of the s 2024, a total of 10,773 vacancies were published in administration and management, which was 3.2% higher compared to the corresponding period of 2023.

Representation of the september of the s 2024, a total of 8,423 vacancies were published in the field of finance, statistics, which was 3.0% higher compared to the corresponding period of 2023.
