NUMBER OF PERSONS RECEIVING A SALARY

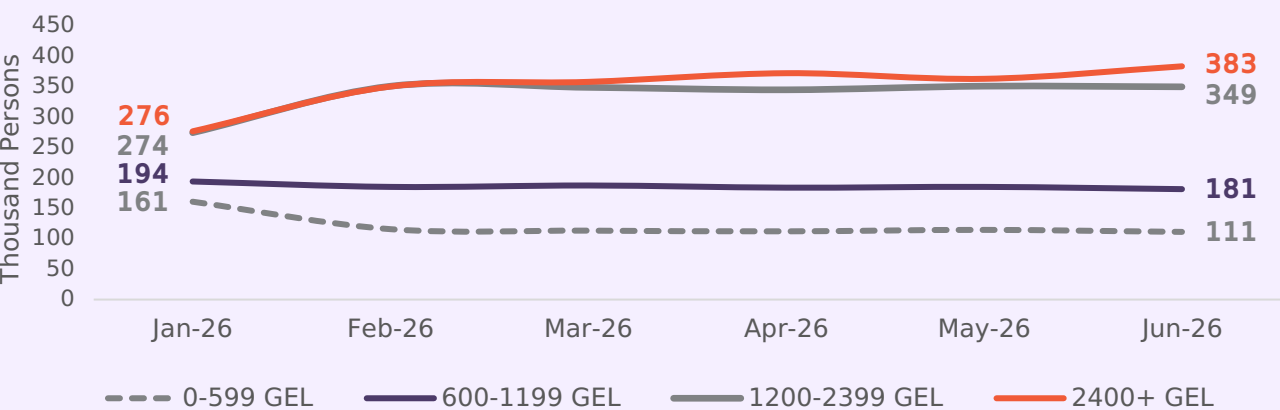
 In June 2026, the number of persons receiving a monthly salary stood at **1,024,954***, representing a 1.2% increase compared with May 2026, and a 2.8% increase compared with June 2025.

 In June 2026, the share of persons receiving a monthly salary of up to **600 GEL** amounted to **10.8%**, which was 0.5 percentage points lower than in May 2026, and 1.5 percentage points lower than in June 2025.

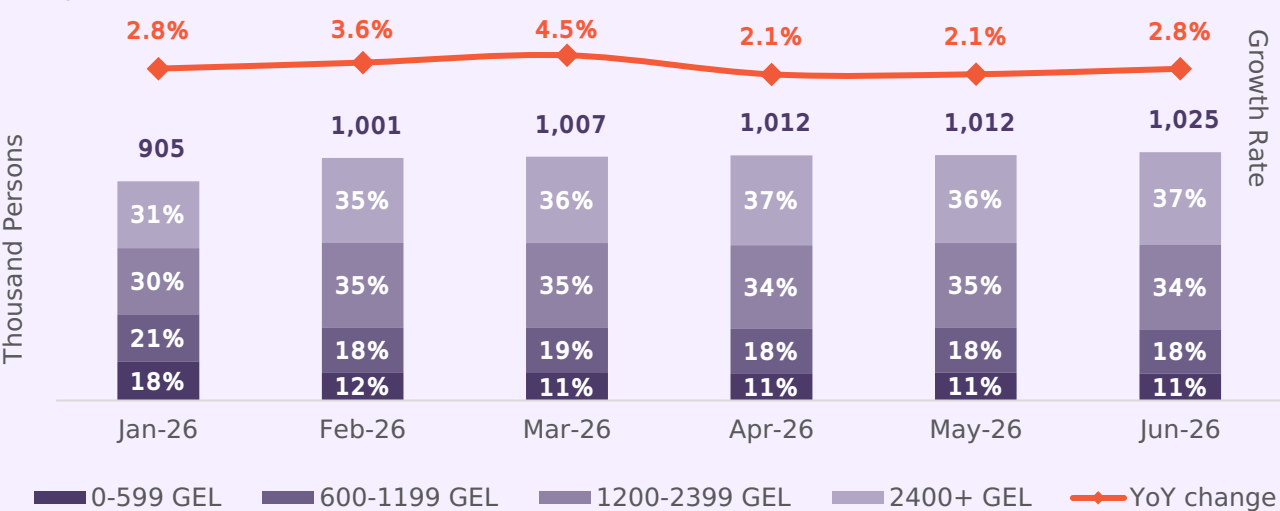
 In June 2026, the share of persons receiving a monthly salary of **2,400 GEL or more** amounted to **37.4%**, which was 1.6 percentage points higher than in May 2026, and 4.6 percentage points higher than in June 2025.

 In June 2026, the share of persons receiving a monthly salary of **9,600 GEL or more** amounted to **3.3%**, which was 0.2 percentage points higher than in May 2026, and 0.5 percentage points higher than in June 2025.

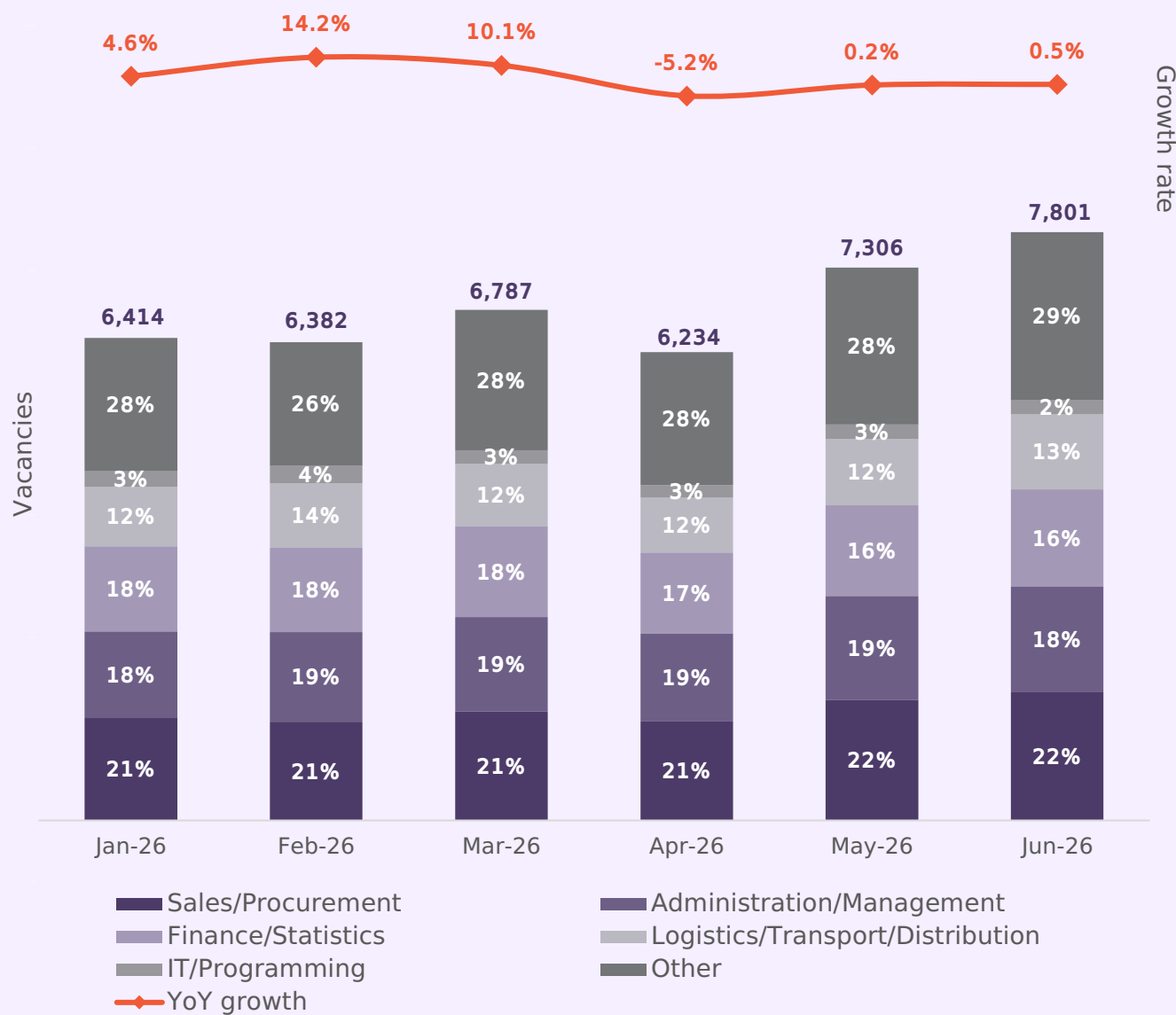
TOTAL VACANCIES PUBLISHED ON jobs.ge

-  In June 2026, the total number of vacancies published on jobs.ge amounted to 7,801, which was 6.8% higher compared with May 2026, and only 0.5% higher compared with June 2025.

 The largest month-over-month increase was observed in the logistics, transport and distribution category (+13.7%), while IT and programming was the only category to record a decrease (-1.3%).
-  The largest year-over-year increase was observed in finance and statistics (+4.9%), while the IT and programming category recorded the biggest decrease (-21.8%).

 From April 2026 to June 2026, the total number of vacancies published on jobs.ge amounted to 21,341, which was 1.3% lower compared to the same period of 2025. The category that contributed the most to the decrease during this period was IT and programming.

VACANCIES PUBLISHED ON jobs.ge BY CATEGORY

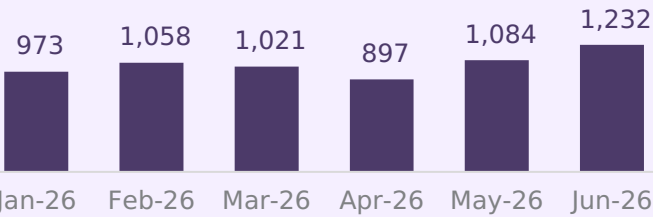
From April 2026 to June 2026, a total of 5,698 vacancies were published in the field of sales and procurement, which was 2.9% higher compared to the corresponding period of 2025.

From April 2026 to June 2026, a total of 4,853 vacancies were published in the field of administration and management, which was 0.9% higher compared to the corresponding period of 2025.

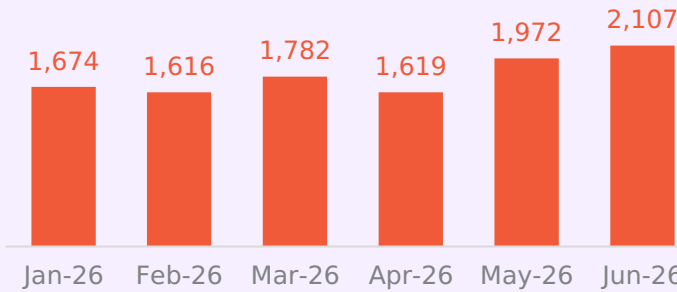
From April 2026 to June 2026, a total of 4,402 vacancies were published in the field of finance and statistics, which was 1.1% higher compared to the corresponding period of 2025.

Graph 4: Number of Vacancies Published on jobs.ge by Category

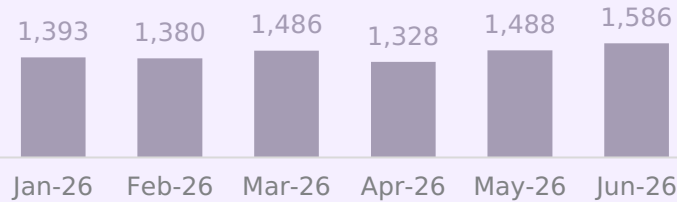

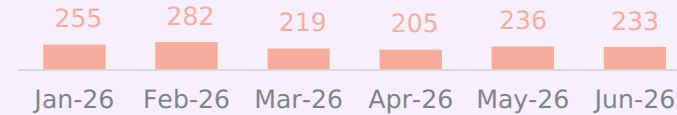

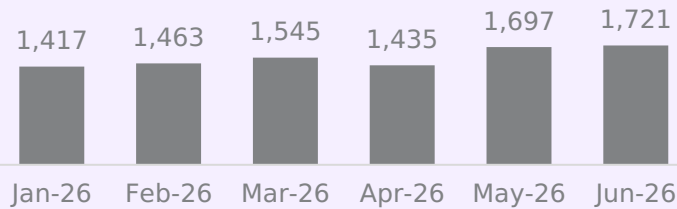

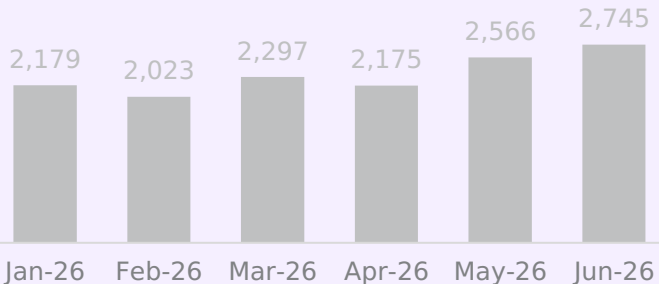

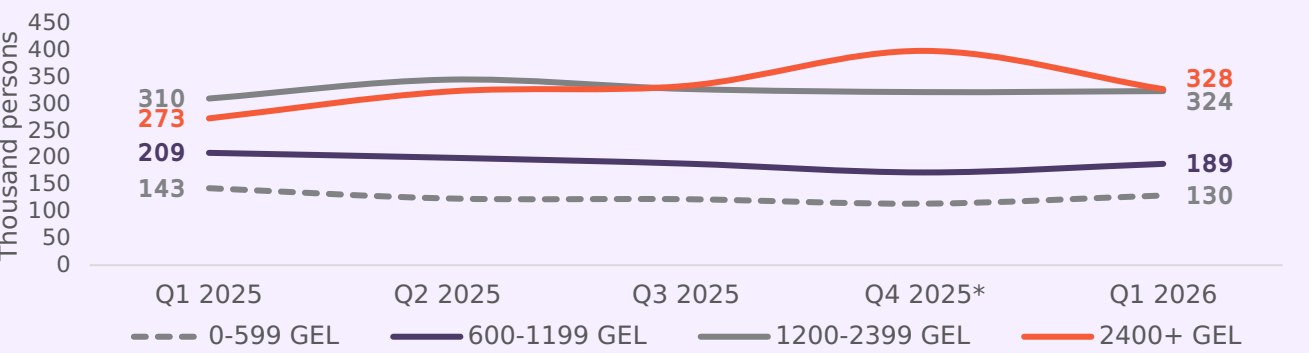

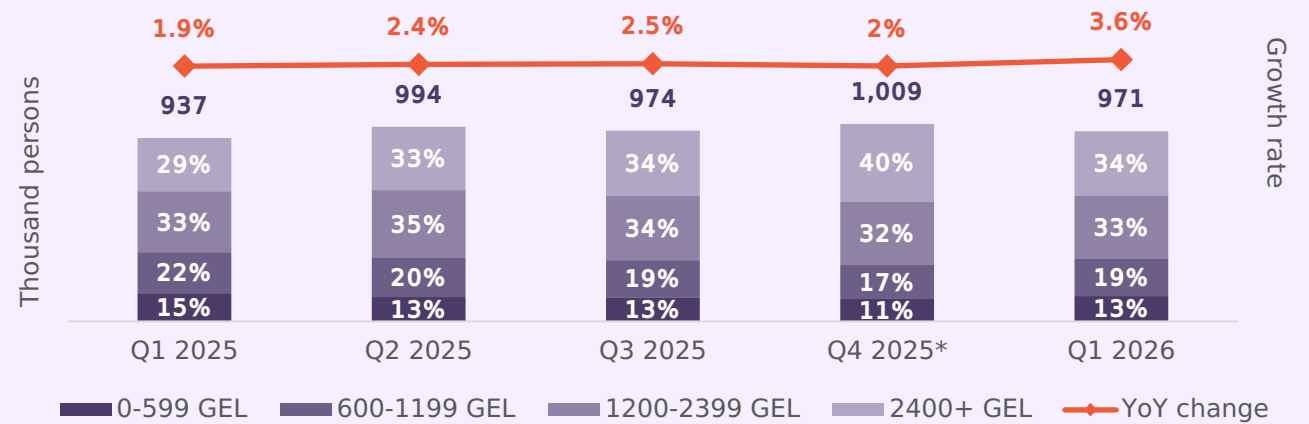

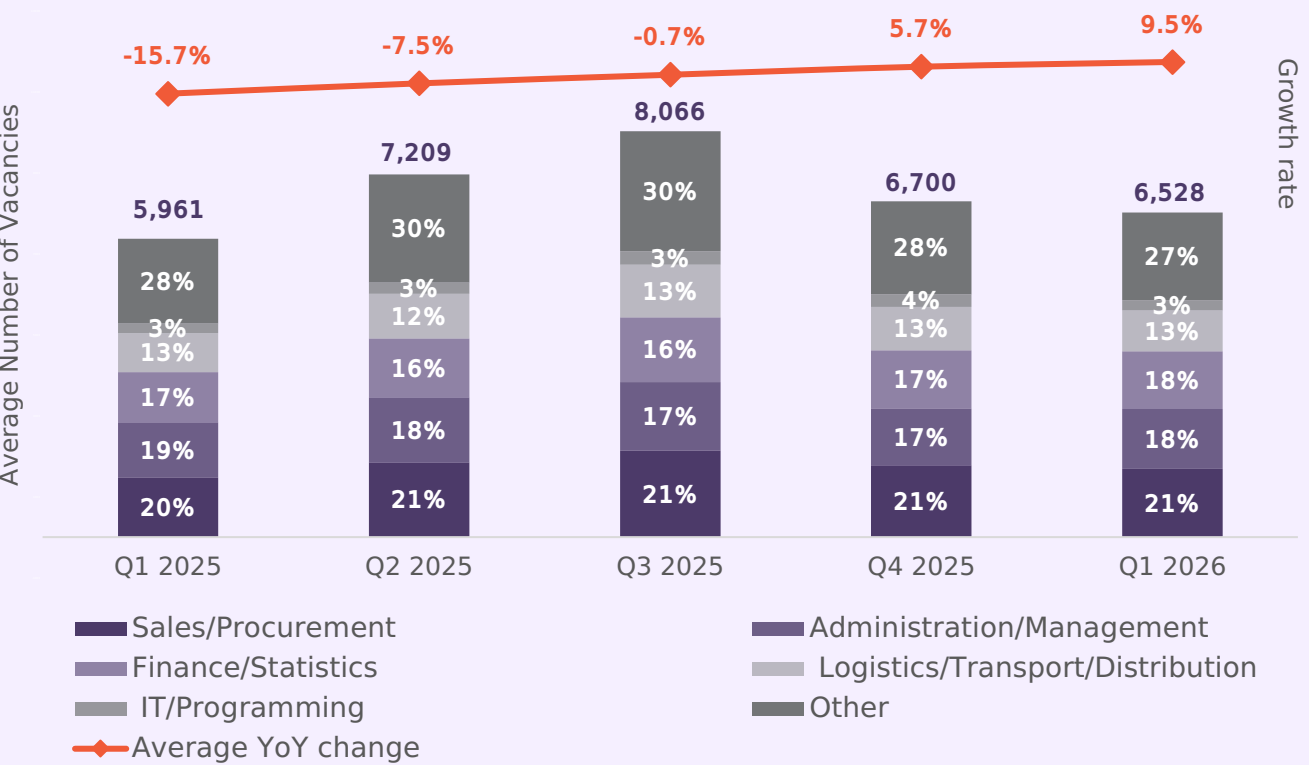
Graph 5: Quarterly Average Number of Persons Receiving a Salary (by Salary Range)
