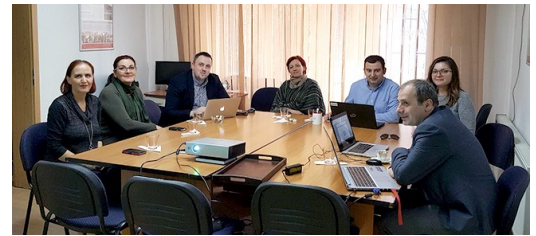
Enhancing Public Finance Management in the Ministry of Justice of Niger
